Dear Friends in Christ, so much has been said and so much to do. Words and apps can become very meaningless, at best empty. Tomorrow as we move into the Passion of Jesus, we have some chance of Light. The Passion was never more timely.

Jesus endured the sense of being abandoned by the one He loved most, his Abba. He chose to experience all of humanity's worst suffering. What does this tell us? Even though he couldn't access their love, do you think the Father and the Spirit were there with Jesus on the cross? Given that this is immeasurable love, how do you respond to it? The Cross of Christ bears the suffering and the sin of mankind, including our own. Jesus accepts all this with open arms, bearing on his shoulders our crosses and saying to us:

"Have courage! You do not carry your cross alone! I carry it with you. I have overcome death and I have come to give you hope, to give you life" (cf. Jn 3:16).... You see, it gives us a treasure that no one else can give: the certainty of the faithful love which God has for us. A love so great that it enters into our sin and forgives it, enters into our suffering and gives us the strength to bear it. It is a love which enters into death to conquer it and to save us. The Cross of Christ contains all the love of God; there we find his immeasurable mercy.

This is a love in which we can place all our trust, in which we can believe.

As I prayed in the church this week, I felt very useless. At 70+ I am an endangered species. I can't even visit the sick and doing a funeral is a bit of a problem. I am a prisoner in my own house. And yet the "useless one" was helpless on the cross, he could not even give himself a cup of water and here it was that he saved the world. Shows the lengths He will go to, to show his love for you and I.

THE SUPREME ACT OF LOVE.

I was good at doing God's work!!!!! I built 15 churches!!!!! But now I have to do "god." Trust Him. Rude awakening. He did not cling to his equality with God, but was humbler and emptied Himself. This is the heart of the Passion/Good News, that Jesus loves us. AT MASS CHRIST IS HIDDEN IN THE BREAD, (for now we are deprived) But Christ lives on the street in the neighbour, helpless, alone and afraid.

We thank all those **angels** on the front line who are serving us and Him so well. God protect you.

As we all go about our daily "run" we may be isolated but we can say a cheery hello even at 10 meters, or a wave etc. Don't lose all contact.
