In today's gospel Jesus tells us that even the unjust judge gives in to the woman. If he can do it how much more will God help us if we only trust Him. **"Pray continually."** If you are praying well, continue doing so. However, how do we pray continually? A tall order. But Jesus says it and we must try to understand. In the Hebrew language vowels are not pronounced. So if we take the name of YAHWEH and leave out the vowels what do we get.....Y-H W-H. Now pronounce that yh wh. It is synonymous with our breathing, yh wh, yh wh, yh wh. So in our breathing we are continually saying the name of God. For those who do good yoga that is what you are trying to do....get in touch and keep in touch with your breathing. Just repeating the name of God. When you popped out of the womb and the midwife slapped you on the rear end.....you gasped and said God. And as you give your last breath, probably with one great gasp and a gurgle you will say yh wh. So we come into the world and leave the world with the name of God on our lips. Wow????

So in between the womb and the tomb we need to be continually in touch with the name of God on our lips. This is why finding quiet time throughout the day to get in touch with our breathing, with yh wh can be very calming and contemplative. And the result is that in between time we have a heightened awareness of yh wh. Praying continually.
