For Franciscan scholar Ilia Delio, compassion stems from knowing that we belong to one another: I think our greatest fear is our deepest desire: to love and to be loved. Deep within we yearn for wholeness in love, but to become more whole in love we must accept our weaknesses and transcend our limits of separation in order to unite in love. We long for oneness of heart, mind and soul, but we fear the demands of unity. Sometimes I think we choose to be alone because it is safe.
